## Description

Congratulations! The semester is almost finished. This document will instruct you how to submit your final project.

## Demo/Presentation

Project presentations will take place on **Monday, July 10** in the Media Computing Lab. A schedule has been posted on the website. It lists the time you are required to demo your project.

On the day of the presentation, please be sure to arrive early to setup up your demo. The lab will open in the morning, if you wish to set up then. During your scheduled time, you will have 5 minutes to demo and talk about your work. No PowerPoint slides please -- we want to see your instrument in action. This will be followed by some brief questions from the judges (roughly 5 minutes). Please stick to the schedule. If you miss your slot, you will not be able to present.

In addition to counting towards your project grade, prizes will be awarded for the best project demonstration. Remember, the demonstration is a **performance** -- it should be fun and entertaining!

## Website

To help us grade your assignment, you will provide a small write-up on the work you did in the form of a website. It should include the following:

- name of project
- name of group members
- brief introduction describing your instrument, and its motivation
- a photo of your instrument

-a high-level list of all the task you completed during this project

-brief description of any problems you encountered (and how you solved them)

-Discuss areas of future work

-Link to your Max/MSP patches.

Note, you will not be graded on the look of your website.

The archive should be standalone and complete, including your Max/MSP patches.

The start page of your web archive should be "index.html"
